- 1. All ARTS and CRAFTS <u>MUST BE HANDCRAFTED</u> by EXHIBITOR. IMPORTED AND MANUFACTURED COMMERCIAL ITEMS ARE PROHIBITED.
- 2. Set up times are Friday between 4:00PM to 7:00PM; SATURDAY morning starting at 8:00am only. All booths must have a responsible person in attendance. YOU are responsible for anything left unattended.
- **3.** Please pull in the craft area only to UNLOAD and LOAD. (Unload everything quickly from your vehicle, then park and walk back to set up. Vehicles must be removed by 9:30 am on Saturday so sales can begin.
- **4.** Craft spaces are 10 feet by 12 feet wide, located along 4th Street between Lake and Oak Street. Individual spaces will be marked on the pavement by strips. YOUR space is between the two lines.
- **5.** On Sunday, in consideration for other crafters and due to traffic problems, we request that you please DO NOT close until at least an hour after the parade or 2:30 PM
- **6.** Porta-potties will be available along with food and beverages booths at the park. Electricity and water are not furnished.
- 7. NO food booths are allowed in the Arts and Crafts portion of the festival
- **8.** There is NO camping allowed in the craft area.
- **9.** Please make sure that you dispose of all your personal trash
- 10. Pets in your booth area are discouraged. If you bring an animal, it MUST be kenneled.
- 11. Confirmation that crafters will be approved will be sent out prior to event; along with vendor assigned space. We will have representatives to help direct you to your proper set up area.
- **12.** We regret, but no refunds for rain or inclement weather are allowed. Any "No-Show" will automatically forfeit their craft application fee.
