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TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. USA Pickleball Official Rulebook (2023) and amendments, if any, will apply.
- 2. This event will be a Round-Robin format with skill level groupings. Partners and opponents change each game, and everyone plays each player in their division/group.
- 2. Games will be played to 11 points with a win by 1 point.
- 3. The teams will change ends of the court when either team reaches 6 points.
- 4. Players may, but are not required to, take a 2-minute warmup before beginning play for each match.
- 5. Disputes should be settled on the court, quickly and amiably, with the benefit of the doubt going to your opponent.
- 6. No scores will be recorded until a player from each team reaches the tournament desk to report the scores.
- 7. The tournament ball is the Franklin X-40 Outdoor pickleball, and the Franklin X-26 or Penn 26, as players agree, Indoor pickleball. If an agreement is not reached the Franklin X-26 will be the default.
- 8. Winners will be determined first, by the number of games won, then in ties, by the total points scored in all games. If a tie still results, then the determination will be made by head-to-head results.
- 10. Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in each division/group.
